##### Web Page

Ms. Zilberfarb will send him some information to get us started on the web page for Environmental.

Mr. Jaronsky will contact Ms. Davis to get answers prior to the hearing at the Planning Board meeting. Mr. DeCarolis did inquire if the old ERI would be incorporated in the new one and if Maser has been contacted for any input.

##### Community Cleanup Day - November 19, 2011

- Ms. Zilberfarb ordered 100 hotdogs and 500 pencils will be ordered that are made of recycled material. They will be engraved with Frelinghuysen Environmental Commission - Reduce Reuse Recycle. She will also post on the sign outside, put in the school newsletter, and post on the webpage. Monetary donations will be made by Chris Kuhn, Alan DeCarolis and Dave Cross. All monies going toward the cost of food and drink. Clean Communities will supply garbage bags, rubber gloves, buckets, 2 roadside cleanup signs and someone to drive behind groups to pick up the bags of trash. Mr. Jaronsky will provide cookies. The Kuhn family will cook and distribute drinks to participants. Ms. Beckenthal will advertise on the radio and Mr. DeCarolis will provide water for washing hands.
