Minutes of Meeting of April 23, 2007

Call to Order

Superfund cleanup on Greendell Road

- A letter was drafted and reviewed and will be sent to Mayor Charles and the Committee Members requesting help in obtaining well water testing for various homes within the township.

Old Creamery Rt 519

- Mr. Dericks spoke with John Tflugsiler, the driver of the two trucks in question, and found out that the trucks are loaded in Philadelphia and driven directly to Ontario, Canada. The trucks transport a chemical called Phenol. After unloading, the trucks are completely flushed at the Canadian site and then driven to the Old Creamery and stored empty. Each truck makes 2 trips per week. When they are parked and empty the placards are still on the truck.
- Mr. Tflugsiler is willing to come and meet with us to discuss any questions people may have.

Planning Board Report

- Johnsonburg Inn filed a variance and got a rubber stamp.
- Joe Pacchia has been granted an extension to the May 7th meeting.
