MEETING MINUTES:

A motion was made by Dr. Tudor to approve the May 15, 2017 minutes seconded by Ms. Smolha. All in favor, aye. Ms. Beckenthal abstained.

Boat House at Kids Camp: Members read Mr. Lubrecht's email regarding the history of the Boat House. A discussion ensued. Ms. Beckenthal stated that she was concerned that the Boat House may be torn down. Ms. Natyzak responded that the Boat House is owned by Green Acres, not the Township, therefore she shouldn't be concerned. A motion was made by Ms. Beckenthal to send a letter to the Township Committee informing them that the Historical Committee is looking to certify the Boat House as a historic building seconded by Dr. Tudor. All in favor, aye. Ms. Natyzak stated that Mr. Lance would be responsible for drafting the letter.

Signage Options for Historical Structures: Ms. Smolha asked Dr. Tudor if he brought photographs of the NYC historic building plaques. He stated that he did not have with him, but would bring them to the next meeting.
