Roll call:

Minutes:

The minutes of the meeting of January 14, 2016 were approved on motion made by Mr. McPeek, seconded by Mrs. Mattos. All were in favor.

Treasurer's report-none

Old Business:

It was decided that Casino Night would be changed to April 9th due to spring break. (Note: the Royal Casino company was unable to do that date and it was changed to April 23rd). Mrs. Mattos will make up a new flyer stating that all proceeds will go towards two No. Warren scholarships. The number of tables will be reduced by two. The food will be discussed next month.

Chairman Desiderio announced that the Township Committee gave the recreation committee the full amount of \$8,000.00 that was requested plus an additional \$6,000 for swing sets for the playground.

Mr. Eitner went over the payment of the sponsorship signs. It was decided that due to non-payment Precision Motors and Mr. DeCarolis signs will be removed. Mr. Durling and Bender Photos have paid. Aspen Tree Service will be handled by Mr. Desiderio.

Mrs. Winfield reported on her findings of a swing set for the playground. There are no swing sets on the Morris County Coop. She has received two quotes as follows:

Toledo-a bipod (4 seats) \$1,767.48 includes shipping & handling plus hardware

Game Time-a bipod \$1,178.00 plus \$76.00 a seat and does not include chains

Mrs. Winfield will research additional companies.

New Business:

Chairman Desiderio reported that he will attend a meeting on April 30th for an outreach program put on by the Warren County Parks Association.

Mr. Desiderio reported that there were a lot of items in the clothing bin that were not acceptable by Fashion Republic and that it took him and another man hours to clean up the non acceptable items. It was decided that the company would be called every two months for pick up. There was 2600 lbs collected for a total of \$442.00.

A family who lives in the township fell upon hard times due to spinal surgery he had will receive \$100.00 from a "Go Fund Me" account. Motion was made by Mr. McPeek, seconded by Mr. Saalfield to send a donation of \$100.00, All were in favor.

Mr. Saalfield presented a check in the amount of \$224.30 from the United Soccer Academy.

Report of Standing Committees:

Movie Night-Mrs. Mattos reported that January's movie night was canceled and will have movie night on Feb. 19th.

Softball/Baseball-Mr. McPeek reported that Independence pulled out of the league. He recommended that we join the Newton Junior Athletic team which will cost \$135.00 to join. This will be done for 2017. The Umpire fees have gone up to \$60.00.

Basketball-Mr. Saalfield asked that the committee donate \$100.00 a team for teams that are going to play in the play-offs. Motion was made by Mr. McPeek,, seconded by Mrs. Mattos to donate the \$100.00. All were in favor.
