Audience Participation:

Consortium of Recreation Programs for the Arts, History, Recreation and Cultural/Environmental Education at the Vass House

Amy Hufnagel from the Hardwick Historical Society presented the committee w/ a plan for the Vass Farmstead, A Center for History, Environment, and Art. She is asking for a partnership w/ the local recreation commissions so the local youth, families and retirees have access to programs beginning spring 2010/summer 2010 @ a subsidized rate.

Program suggestions are:

Building using history, story/interpretation, exhibition programs, hiking, camping (day/week) art, theater and so forth. If we choose to participate the township would have access to the house, facility, events, biking and rentals parties etc.

The projects need funding from grants first.

She is asking for \$2000.00 each from 12 townships which builds \$24,000.00, and then goes to the foundation for an additional \$85,000.00 in support. This will take time. Two local Townships have confirmed commitment to this project. All others are pending.

The committee has decided to go w/ this program. Kim L. will contact Amy for future details on what the letter should say.

Monies will be drawn from the 2008 budget.
