

## **MINUTES OF MEETING OF MARCH 1, 2012**

The budget meeting of the Frelinghuysen Township Committee was held in the Municipal building, 210 Main Street, Johnsonburg, New Jersey on Thursday, March 1, 2012 and was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Mayor Charles.

### **SUNSHINE LAW STATEMENT:**

### **ROLL CALL:**

Those present were: Mayor Thomas Charles, Deputy Mayor Frank Desiderio, Committeeman Alan DeCarolis, Committeeman Dale Durling, Committeeman David Boynton, Chief Finance Officer Gene Marie McCartney, Auditor Anthony Ardito and Clerk Brenda Kleber.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

An emergency quote for electrical work at the Town garage was received in the amount of \$450.00. Motion was made by DeCarolis, seconded by Desiderio approving the quote. All were in favor.

A letter received from Laura Brill to update the tax maps which were last revised in 2008 at a cost not to exceed \$3000.00 was not approved due to budget constraints.

The Clerk advised that she has been approached by an electrical company to lower the electrical costs at the town hall and garage. It was decided that she would obtain additional quote. This was done on motion made by Desiderio, seconded by Durling. All were in favor.

### **BUDGET:**

At this time, the Committee went over the budget with the auditor and eliminated some expenditures in the budget. The budget will be introduced at the March 21<sup>st</sup> meeting.

### **ADJOURNMENT:**

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
