The special meeting of the Frelinghuysen Township Committee was held at the Kids Camp, Lincoln Laurel Road on Sunday, February 9, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.

SUNSHINE LAW STATEMENT:

Under the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, adequate notice of this meeting was provided by posting notice on the township bulletin board and by e mailing notice to the New Jersey Herald and The Express-Times.

The 124 acre parcel consists of approximately 24,000 square feet of buildings, including a lodge, mess hall, cabins, nurse's station, in ground pool, stable, lake, fields, streams and woodlands.

After the tour the committee decided they will discuss this further with the Open Space and Farmland Preservation Committees along with the Township Committee at their meeting of February 19, 2014.
