7:30PM - Town hall will be open on Wednesday from 8am to 6pm. If you need to fill water containers, to recharge cell phones or computers, access will be available.

In addition, the Frelinghuysen Elementary School will be closed both Wednesday and Thursday.

Road access on many of the township roads is still dangerous, please use caution should you need to drive.

11:40AM - If you have damage on your property, please report the damage to Frelinghuysen OEM, Nick Pachnos @ (908) 256-6355. Provide a list of the damage and an approximate estimate of repairs. He will use that information to report to proper officials.

11:15AM - The following roads are closed:

Rt 612 between Johnsonburg and South St.

Kerrs Corner between tunnel and Rt 94

Heller Road
South Street
State Park Road
Silver Lake Road
Main St. between Rt. 612 and Rt. 519

In some cases the road crew has cleared these roads for emergency vehicles, best advise is to stay off these roads.

Town hall will be open until 8pm, but will re-open by request.

9:50AM - The road crew is out clearing township roads to provide access for emergency vehicles. There are many trees down throughout the township along with power lines down. Please, if you absolutely need to travel on these roads, use extreme caution.

Currently Nick Pachnos is assessing the situation within our borders and will provide an update later this morning. Feel free to contact him if you have a situation in your area that requires his response (908) 256-6355.

At this time, there are 950 Frelinghuysen residents without power.

7:50AM - Residents please stay off the road as many township roads are closed due to downed trees and/or power lines. Should you require assistance Town Hall is open for shelter, food and water.
