3:10pm - Frelinghuysen Elementary School will be closed on Friday Nov. 2.

12:00pm - Due to the lack of DSL service in the area, our updates are difficult to get out.

As of late yesterday afternoon, JCP&L has 940,000 customers still without service. They are working from the main feeder lines back to the substations and then to the various towns. Tree crews and assessment teams are working in the area. As you know this storm is of historical proportion. Be sure to report your power loss, if you have not done so already by calling them @ 1-888-544-8058.

Many of the township roads are still closed, but passable. Please use caution around any that you see with downed lines.

Town hall is open today and tomorrow from 8am to 6pm. Should power not be restored by Saturday it will be open from 10am to 12pm. If needed for emergency on Sunday, contact Nick Pachnos @ (908) 256-6355. There is a hose at the water bib on the outside of the building for after hour access. The location is next to the mailboxes.

Gas for refueling cars and generators is in scarce supply. Many residents have been successful going to Stroudsburg and Bartonsville, PA.

If you have storm related damage, you can start the process with FEMA for financial assistance by calling 1-800-621-FEMA.

We have no update at this time regarding the elementary or high school schedule. Once we find out an update will be sent out.

Just a reminder, Governor Christie has decreed that Halloween will be celebrated on Monday, November 5th in the State of New Jersey.
