The following roads are still closed and had the most damage: Ramsey Road (Route 661), Kerr's Corner Road, State Park Road, Greendell Road, Silver Lake Road and Mill Street. The US Army and the County have arrived in our township to assist in the cleanup efforts this afternoon and will continue to do so tomorrow.



Due to the amount of damage at the substations, JCP&L has determined between now and Wednesday most residents will have power service restored. There will also be some remote sections of the town that will take longer.
