This officially declares that the State of Emergency as a result of Hurricane Sandy in the Township of Frelinghuysen has been rescinded.

This announcement is being issued as a matter of protocol, because a township-wide state of emergency no longer exists. This does not stop the process of FEMA reimbursements for individuals or businesses which have been impacted by the storm. The Office of Emergency Management is still available for issues related to safety; concerns about phone or cable service should be directed to your provider.

Thank you all for your updates on power restoration via email or our presence on Facebook.

There has been much progress in the past two days and we are aware there are still some sections of town that have not been restored. Power crews are working in the area, so please be patient you will not be forgotten.

Nick Pachnos has reported that some parts of State Park Rd., Kerrs Corner Rd., Mill St., Ackerson Rd. and Rt 519 are still without power. There are also some individual homes that may have some power lines down. Please provide the latter information directly to us so we can insure the work gets expedited.
