


Share The Road!

Putting our community in motion.

Thanks to a grant from Wal-Mart through Frelinghuysen Township's participation in the Sustainable Jersey program, we were able to establish a "Safe Route" throughout our town so our motorists can safely "Share the Road" with our pedestrians and cyclists.

The entire route is over nine miles long. With the money we received through the Wal-Mart grant, we were able to install safety road signs along the route, place a bike rack behind Town Hall and make shoulder repairs to some of the township roads.

As part of the Mayors Wellness Campaign, we are trying to get our community moving. Our purpose in implementing this "Safe Route" is to increase the awareness of drivers, pedestrians and cyclists. Through this, we also were able to improve the road shoulder conditions for cyclists and walkers in order to minimize the need to travel in the automobile lanes. In general, we want to raise the road safety consciousness of the community.
