## Traffic and Speeding Issues

Dear Residents,

Earlier this year there have been three accidents at the intersection of County Route 661 (Ramsey Road), Main Street, and County Route 519 (Dark Moon Road). As the intersection is between two Warren County roads, it falls under the jurisdiction of Warren County. The Township Committee has authorized Paul Sterbenz, P.E., the Township Engineer, to address the matter with the Warren County Engineer's Office, which he did on April 8, 2015. In that regard, Mr. Sterbenz noted speed issues and site distance issues appeared to be contributing factors in the accidents. We are awaiting a response from the County, and will keep the public posted on how the matter progresses.

Members of the public also brought to the Township Committee's attention speed issues on Greendell Road, which is a Township road. We have informed the State Police, who have indicated they will step up enforcement of the posted speed limits on Greendell Road, which are 35MPH or 40MPH, depending on the location.

Likewise, members of the public also brought to the Township Committee's attention speed issues on County Route 612 (Johnsonburg Road) in the vicinity of the intersection with South Street near the old Clark Farm. The posted speed limit in that particular area is 35MPH. We have informed the State Police, who have indicated it will be stepping up enforcement of the posted speed limit in that area.

We thank the public for bringing these issues to the attention of the Township Committee, and we encourage the public to continue to do so. The Township Committee cannot take effective action with regard to matters of which we are not aware.
